

Vernon Vortex Parent Information and Volunteer Policy Commitment

Vernon Vortex Speed Skating Club is a collection of parent volunteers. As these volunteers perform all duties, we must endure a minimum level of commitment from each member.

At this time, the Board of Directors has established the following expectations for all members. These include?

- ! All members shall arrive to the rink with their child and send time prior to the beginning of the ice session putting MATS and WATER out onto the ice and the removal of same at the conclusion of the final ice session. Helmets and shoe grips are highly recommended.
- ! All members are expected to have their skater on the ice and ready to participate at the designated start time of the session. This means arriving early enough to ensure your skater is not late. It is important for skaters to be warmed up prior to program sets.
- ! All members are required to volunteer for the various activities and events throughout the season. More information will be provided throughout the season.
- ! All members are required to provide a post dated cheque in the form of a volunteer deposit upon Registration. Failing to volunteer will result in the forfeiting of the deposit. If volunteer commitments are fulfilled, the cheque is returned or destroyed.
- ! All members must complete the Registration package in full, sign the Parent Information form and hand the completed documents in with payment prior to the end of the designated Registration night. Skate rental and Associate member fees will be required with the first installment, if paying in installments. The first installment will be calculated as half the total amount, plus rentals, plus member fees plus levies.
- ! All members are required as part of Registration to register their skater(s) and one parent as an associate member with the BCSSA online registration portal prior to the first night of skating. Any skaters not registered will not be allowed on the ice due to insurance issues.
- ! REFUND POLICY: Cancellations of Registration require written notice to the BOD prior to Nov 1. NO REFUNDS will be given for cancellations after Nov 30.
- ! All parents agree to read and follow the Return To Sport Plan and Illness Policy in regards to COVID-19 and to not attend practice or events if the skater is feeling unwell.
